The Regular meeting of the Town of Scott was called to order at 7:00 pm by Councilman Jerry Contento and followed with the Pledge of the Allegiance.

County Legislator Report:

Legislator Donnell Boyden explained to the Board that the county was working on a proposal that would allow the Towns to set up their own dates and times for amnesty day clean up as long as they stayed within their allowed amount of refuse. It went through the committee and will be brought up to the floor at next meeting. He also told the Board that he had bad news about the recycling center. They have already used 74% of their budget in the first 5 months of operation. The recycling center is not making any revenue because the recyclables are not worth much. Madison County is doing well so they have asked them to come down and council them with ideas to help fix this problem.

After the Board looked over the letter they gave Town Clerk Tamara Congdon permission to sign in behalf of the Board. **Councilwoman Neeca Root made a motion to sign to accept the proposal to support the Syracuse Water Shed and was seconded by Councilwoman Paula Arnold. All in favor, none opposed, the motion carries.**
